Furthermore, we are delighted to announce provisions for awards across various sections, aimed at honoring outstanding performers.

Moreover, we are privileged to host iconic figures and renowned scientists in the field of veterinary science, who will share their invaluable experiences. Their presence promises to broaden our horizons. In light of this, we are asking for abstracts under following disciplines:

**Animal production research:** Intern research of current semester/ year on animal management and nutrition or any other relevant areas.

**Clinical research:** Intern research of current semester/ year on animal disease and treatment or any other relevant areas.





### **GENERAL INSTRUCTION**

- 1. Only the intern students of current session are eligible for abstract submission.
- 2. Prior submitting, the intern student must ensure that his/ her supervisor is aware of its contents.
- 3. Submitted abstract(s) should include data from own intern research and it should be unpublished and or not presented in any other conferences.
- 4. If selected, the inter student himself/ herself have to present the research in person in the conference.
- 5. The conference committee will decide whether the selected research will be presented orally or in a poster presentation.

## **ABSTRACT SUBMISSION PROCESS**

### A. Preparation of Abstract

- Please prepare your abstract in specific format provided as word document file named "Abstract Format"
- ❖ The abstract should be prepared in a popular word processor such as Microsoft Word or Google Docs. Please use Times New Roman, size 12, with 1.5 line spacing for the texts.
- The abstract should contain: A title, Authors information, Body and Keywords.
  - I. **Title:** The title should be comprehensive and go straight to the point of the study.
  - II. Authors information: Full name of student and supervisor with affiliations.
- III. **Body:** The body should contain the following parts in <u>unstructured form (i.e., It should</u> contain the following parts without any heading).
  - A general introduction: The introduction should provide a concise background to the research and outline its aims/objectives.
  - **Key methodologies:** It should be in simple and concise form.
  - Results: It should be the summary of the main findings and related to the aims/objectives.
- IV. **Conclusion:** The conclusion should highlight the implications of significant findings.
- V. **Keywords:** Beneath the abstract text, it is recommended to include up to five keywords. The keywords should be arranged alphabetically.
- ❖ The abstract should not contain any figure, image, table or reference.
- ❖ Word limits: The total number of words excluding spaces, title, author names, and affiliations is limited to 250.
- Students must strictly follow the above guidelines to be considered for evaluation.
