OFFICE ORDER

Avijit Talukder, Associate Professor, Department of Marine Bioresource Science, Faculty of Fisheries, Chattogram Veterinary and Animal Sciences University (CVASU), Chattogram, Bangladesh has been granted study leave on full average pay with effect from 29/07/2026 to 06/07/2029 to attend the Ph.D course at the Indian Institute of Technology Delhi, India as per Leave Rules of this University under the following terms and conditions:

Terms and conditions:

- (1) He will draw his salary and allowance as per leave rules.
 - (2) He will not get any salary in foreign currency.
 - (3) He will not be allowed to stay abroad beyond the permitted period.
 - (4) He is required to send his academic progress report through his supervisor after every semester/year.
 - (5) The period of granted study leave may be extended subsequently on the basis of his academic progress report as per existing/Revised leave rules.
 - (6) He cannot change his registration/university/course of study without prior permission from this university authority.
 - (7) After successful completion of his degree, he should have to return immediately to the university and will resume the teaching/duties.
 - (8) Within seven (7) days of his return to Bangladesh, he must submit a joining report and a research report to the University.
 - (9) He is required to send his overseas contact address including e-mail & telephone number.
 - (10) Neither the University nor the Government of Bangladesh shall bear any financial responsibility or liability in connection with this visit/research. All expenses shall be borne by the authority of Indian Institute of Technology Delhi, India or by the applicant himself.
 - (11) The period of granted study leave shall be counted as "Deputation with Active/Qualifying service" onwards determination of seniority, pension and annual increment(s). But the financial benefits of increment(s) during the period of study leave will be counted on resumption of duties after expiry of the granted leave without arrear.
