Guidelines for Animal Experimentation Ethics Committee (AEEC) of the Chittagong Veterinary and Animal Sciences University

Background

The Chittagong Veterinary and Animal Sciences University (CVASU) is an academic institute with primary interests in education and applied research/experimental research on the field of Veterinary & Animal Science and allied disciplines. Conducting applied or guidelines with the aim of ensuring animals. For that the CVASU wants to set certain animals in different research purposes. This is particularly relevant as many CVASU members are involved directly in studying animal welfare and ethics, or are involved in should have a set of written guidelines to provide its members with a basis for structured planning research involving the use of animals. It is the intent of the CVASU-AEEC that these guidelines will serve to encourage appropriate research.

CVASU conduct a wide variety of studies using disparate species in very different consequence, are broad rather than specific. The focus is therefore on the ethical principles and how to handle these, rather than a list of do's and don'ts applicable to all scenarios.

2. Introduction

The use of animals in research and education has attracted ethical concern for many years, most notably in toxicology and bio-medical studies. More recently, ethical concerns have been raised over less invasive studies. This raises a strong need for conducted in an ethically sound and acceptable manner. Veterinary & Animal Science used as surrogates for humans in research, education and testing. Animal sare frequently designed to lend to the saving of life or to improving the health of man or other probability that they will lead to a contribution of knowledge. But widespread use of need to address animals welfare concerns.

The above considerations have prompted the establishment of an AEEC in CVASU conducting research responsible for ensuring compliance with accepted standard that protect the welfare of the research animals.

CVASU: Centre for excellence in livestock research and education, utilizes animals for many of its research activities, and the need to form an AEEC has been felt for some time. The AEEC will do for animals what the Ethical Review Committee does for human subjects.

The document provides guidelines for the establishment and functioning of the Animal Experimentation Ethics Committee (AEEC) at CVASU.

3. Statement of Principles

The CVASU as an academic and research institute should, like any such body, institute and follow AEEC prescribed guidelines for research on Veterinary & Animal Science and related fields.

- a) Scientists must clearly justify the use of animals; and demonstrate that the experiment cannot be performed in vitro.
- Laboratory animals must be kept under care of professionally qualified persons and according to internationally accepted husbandry practices specific to each animal species. This relates to space, type and frequency of intake of food and water, bedding, temperature and adequate ventilation. They should be regularly inspected and their well being be assessed, cages cleaned and bedding replaced according to the regulations.
- Animals should be handled in accordance with the accepted procedures specific for each species of animals by suitably qualified persons.
- d) Procedures to be performed on animals must be such that they are within the acceptable norms, and attempts should be made at all times to minimize the pain associated with each procedure.
- Whenever possible, procedures should be carried out using local or general anaesthesia appropriate for the particular species of animal.
- f) As soon as illness is apparent, animals used for experiments should be sacrificed humanely.
- In procedures that require starvation, the duration of withdrawal of food should be kept to a minimum.
- h) Upon completion of each experiment, animals should immediately be sacrificed humanely applying the method prescribed for the particular species.
- i) Scientists should provide justification as to the number of animals required for each experiment. While adequate numbers should be used to generate statistically significant findings, the number should nevertheless be kept to a minimum.

4. Relationship of the AEEC with CVASU

- a) The AEEC (or the Committee) is the sole independent body concerned with granting ethical clearance for the use of animals for scientific experiments.
- b) The Director (Research and Extension) CVASU, through the Head of department will ensure that decisions of the Committee are properly implemented.
- In case of disagreement between the Committee and the Principal Investigators, the matter shall be placed to the Vice Chancellor (VC), CVASU whose decision shall be considered final.
 - d) The AEEC is accountable to the VC and the normal line of communication will be through the member secretary of the Committee.

Composition and Size

- a) The AEEC shall comprise members representing 2 notable Bangladeshi organizations, 2 faculty members including at least one amongst the professors appointed by the VC.
- b) A member will serve the AEEC for a three-year term and will not ordinarily serve for more than six consecutive years. The mechanism for such extension will be developed by the AEEC keeping in mind the need for continuity in the Committee. The Ex-Officio (institutional) members of the Committee once appointed shall hold office for a period of three years even if they move out of their current positions to maintain continuity of its functions.
- c) The Committee shall elect from among itself a Chairperson and the Director (Research and Extension) CVASU will be the Member-Secretary.

6. Mode of Operation

- a) The Committee shall meet at least twice a year, to review protocols, inspect facilities, and inquire about the progress of research, which they had reviewed and accorded approval.
- b) Additional meetings may be convened as and when necessary.
- c) No modification relating to the use of animals for experiments for the AEEC-approved protocols should be made without prior approval of the AEEC. The investigators should submit the proposal for proposed change(s) with proper justifications, for consideration of the AEEC. The AEEC, if considers necessary,

will provide an opportunity to the scientists to present/discuss with the proposed changes.

7. Committee Meetings

- a) Notices for meetings of AEEC indicating date, time, venue along with agenda and documents, shall be circulated to Chairperson, Co-Chairperson and members of the Committee at least 10 (ten) days prior to the date of mandatory meetings, and 5 (five) days before the additional meetings.
- b) In absence of the Chairman a member, to be elected by the members present, shall preside over the meeting(s).
- c) Presence of fifty percent of the full members will form a quorum in a meeting. However, for the adjourned meetings a quorum will not be required.
- d) AEEC Application Form (Appendix B) along with copies of the protocol shall be submitted to the Animal Ethics Committee Secretariat. The Member-Secretary shall the requirements for submission.
- e) The Principal Investigator (PI) along with co-investigators will be invited to the meeting of the AEEC to present the protocol, and all participating in the protocol are expected to be present.
- f) Investigator(s) will be informed of the decision of the Committee, in writing, in respect of their protocol after the meeting.
- g) In case of urgency, the Member-Secretary, however, upon proper review may accord ad-hoc approval of any protocol, which requires immediate implementation but the meeting of the AEEC cannot be convened at a short subsequently, the proposal will be allowed to start the research protocol and approval.
- h) The Committee should, if it wishes, meet with the investigators of some specific studies. In such cases, arrangements can be made through the Member-Secretary.
